Flood

Due to torrential rains that caused the Pase and Keureten Rivers to overflow, several sub-districts in Aceh Utara, Province of Aceh were flooded. 1,505 people were affected and evacuated to safer areas by authorized agencies.

The sub-districts that were affected are Matang Kuli, Tanah

Luas, Samudera, Geureudong Pase, Muara Batu, Sawang, Pirak Timu, Lhoksukon, and Nisam. The 1,505 people that were evacuated are from the sub-district of Matang Kuli.

The flooding occurred on Sunday morning and has now receded to a height of 70cm.

The district level of the National

Disaster Management Authority (BNPB) is continuously conducting loss and damage assessments.
